CONDITIONS OF PLAY
CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

OPEN SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIP

Only the current winner of the Club Open Singles Championship may be entered in the Open Singles Champion of Champions. Runners-up or substitutes are not permitted to enter.

Note: Should a player win both the Club Open Singles and the Club Senior Singles Championship during the same year the player may enter **ONLY** the Open Singles Champion of Champions for that year. The Club will not be represented in the Senior Singles Champion of Champions for that year.

SENIOR SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIP

Only the current winner of the Club Senior Singles Championship may be entered in the Senior Singles Champion of Champions. Should a Club not stage a Club Senior Singles Championship, the Club may not enter a player in the Senior Champion of Champions. Runners-up or substitutes are not permitted to enter.

NOVICE SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIP

Only the current winner of the Club Novice Singles Championship may be entered in the Novice Singles Champion of Champions. Should a Club not stage a Club Novice Singles Championship, the Club may not enter a player in the Novice Champion of Champions. As qualification for the Champion of Champions, the District recognises a Novice as a player who:

- Has a valid Bowls SA membership card
- Has played bowls for less than 5 years.
- Has won the current year Club Novice Singles Championship.
- Has not won a Singles Championship at any Club.
- Has not won a Club or District Championship or a District Competition (Saturday and Midweek League is excluded)

Runners-up or substitutes are not permitted to enter.

Please apply these guidelines when entering your players in the Champion of Champions Tournament.
